With the help of volunteers, Cleveland Maidan Association has shipped medical, humanitarian, financial, and military aid to Ukraine, and continues to do so to date.





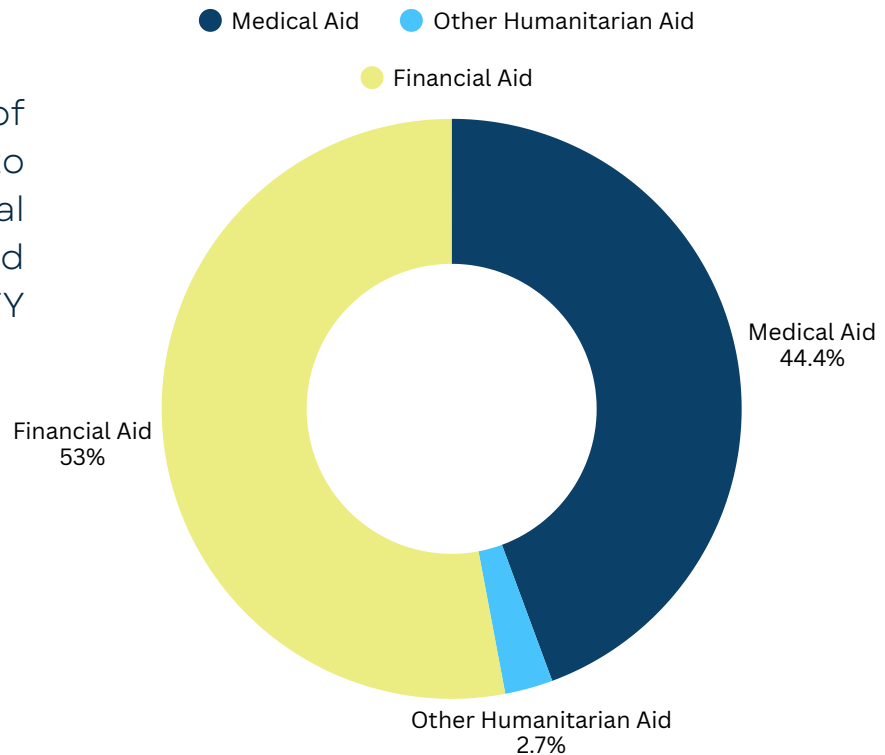

A Year in Review

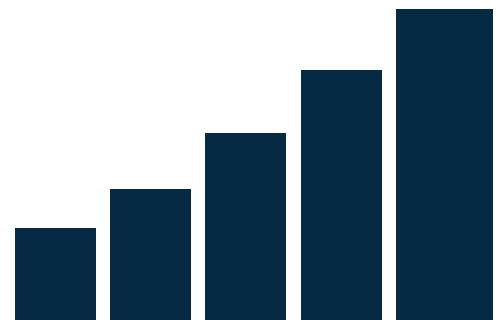
This chart reflects the value of items and financial aid shipped to Ukraine or distributed to local refugee populations by Cleveland Maidan Association throughout FY 2025.

Frontline Medical Medic Training Partnership

In 2023, Cleveland Maidan Association acquired a partnership with Frontline Medical to collaboratively sponsor an upcoming medic training program in Ukraine. This partnership has grown in 2025 with the continuation of training and the building of 32 modular units for use across Ukraine.

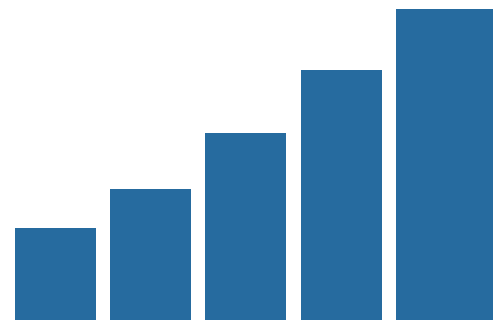

Providing Safe Transport

In 2025, Cleveland Maidan Association supported the sponsorship, purchase, and shipment of 16 quad bikes to support the medic training program. Frontline Medical Ukraine provided a total of 92 quad bikes to the program.

With these bikes, medics are able to safely transfer the injured and expedite treatment and recovery. In total, this \$200,000 investment has supported a program that has reduced limb loss and death by 90% on the frontlines.

Financial Aid for Families of the Heros

Since 2014, Cleveland Maidan Association has operated a robust financial aid program for the families of fallen and injured Ukrainian defenders. This program has continued strong in 2025.

Families receive an average of \$300 be used for the purchase of items they need, such as clothing, food, or housing costs. This approach gives individuals the autonomy to prioritize what will most help them get back on their feet after injury or loss.

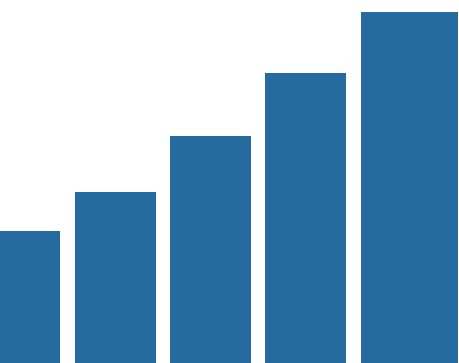
Medical Knowledge Exchange Program

In 2025, the Cleveland Maidan Association significantly expanded its role in medical education. As one of the founding organizations of UA-MED, we made a meaningful impact on Ukraine's healthcare landscape and helped strengthen capacity for long-term growth.

UA-MED, together with its many partners, hosted a series of conferences that brought together medical experts, leaders, and innovators from around the world:

- Kyiv – 23–24 September 2025
- Lviv – 26–27 September 2025
- Boston – 7–8 November 2025

Together, these events formed a unified initiative aimed at transforming healthcare systems in Ukraine's crisis-affected regions.



Medical Mission Program

Cleveland Maidan Association is proud to sponsor medical exchange trips to share groundbreaking medical knowledge with our Ukrainian counterparts.

This program centers of systems strengthening and capacity-building, preparing the next generations of Ukrainian medical professionals for a bright future.

In 2025, CMA sponsored two urology medical exchange trips In Lviv, Ukraine in June and October. The project included corrective surgeries and training of peer urologists in the latest technology and methods.
